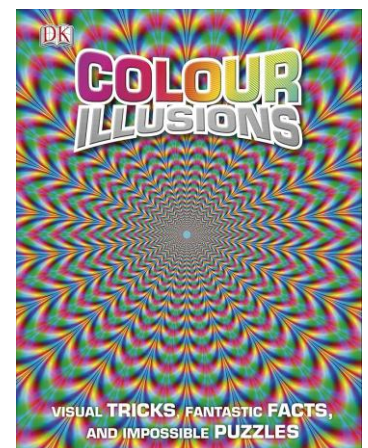
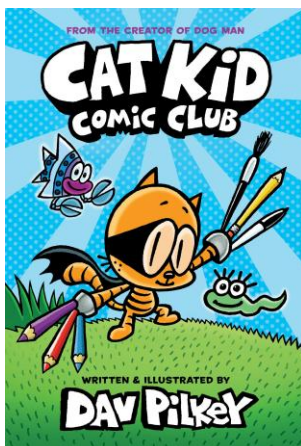
Recommended Reads: by children for children....

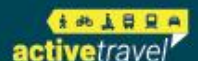

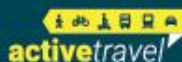
